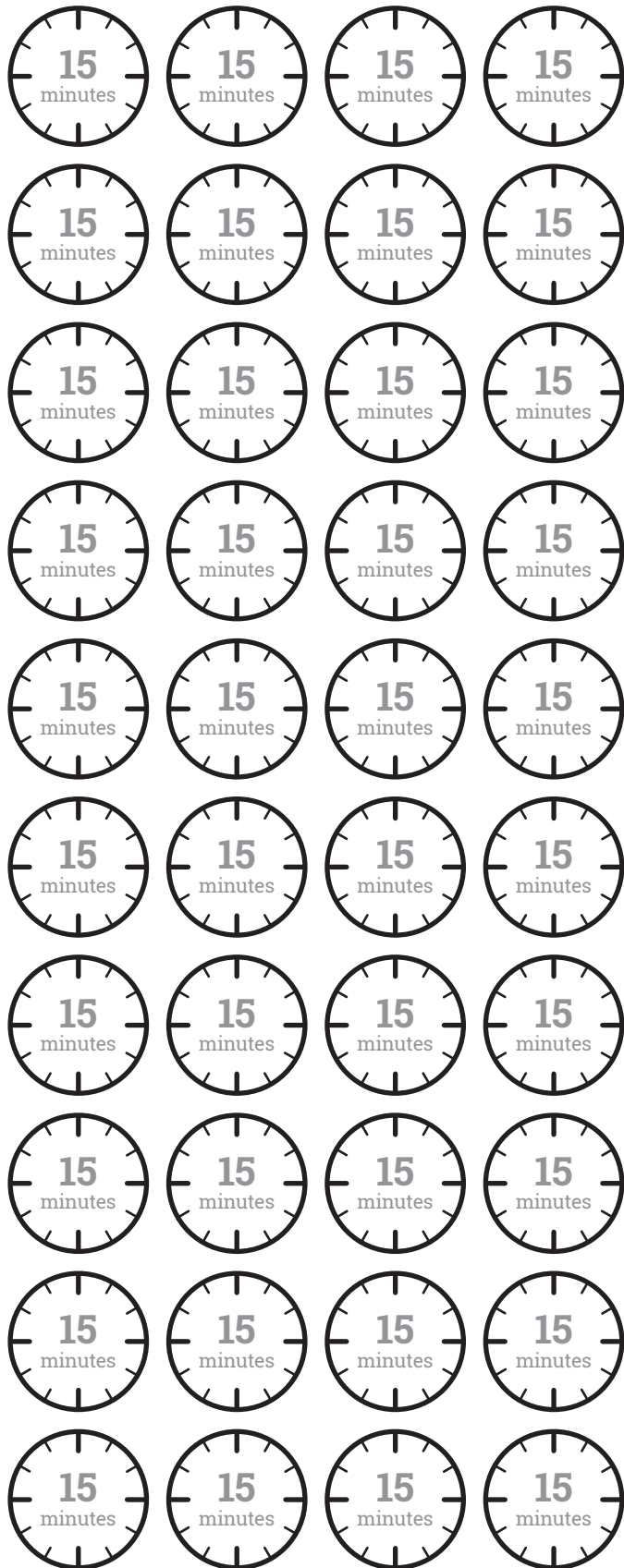

Summer Reading Challenge Details

Pennsylvania PBS stations have joined together to host the first statewide Summer Reading Challenge! Readers will be divided into three categories: K–1, 2–3, and 4–5 graders.

- Between **June 1–July 31, 2018**, all readers will keep a log of books read and their time spent reading on the Summer Reading Challenge Book Log.
- **K–3 Readers** must read at least one PBS-related book (such as *Clifford*, *Cat in the Hat*, *Daniel Tiger*, etc.)
- **Grade 4–5 Readers** must also watch at least one episode from a PBS show (such as *Nature*, *Nova*, or *American Experience*, etc.) and read a book related to the episode topic
- Part of another summer reading contest? Those books count, too! Just include them on this Book Log!
