

Any individual (each such individual is hereinafter referred to as a "Participant") who enters, attempts to enter, or in any way participates or attempts to participate in the PBS Prize Basket drawing on Saturday, September 21, 2019 ("Drawing") conducted by The Pennsylvania State University on behalf of its WPSU ("Penn State") agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions provided in these Official Drawing Rules ("Rules"), as well as by Penn State's interpretations of these Rules, which are final and binding in all matters relating to any Drawing.

1. No Purchase Necessary. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN A PRIZE. A PURCHASE WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.
2. Applicable Law/Void Where Prohibited. The Drawing is subject to and governed by applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Participation in this Drawing is void where prohibited or otherwise restricted by law.
3. Eligibility. The Drawing is open to legal residents of the United States of America, who are at least 18 years of age or older at time of entry, except that the following individuals are not eligible for the Drawing: (a) employees within WPSU; (b) any individual involved in the sponsorship of any Prize of the Drawing, and immediate family members (and those living in the same household, whether or not related) of any of the foregoing. Immediate family members shall include spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws", or by current or past marriage, remarriage, adoption, co-habitation or other familial extension.

Entry. To enter the Drawing, an individual must provide to Penn State a mobile phone number capable of receiving text messages. Message rates may apply and will be the responsibility of the entrant. Entries must be made on Saturday, September 21 by 3PM EDT. Penn State is not responsible for problems with Drawing entries, including but not limited to, entries which are lost, late, misdirected, damaged, incomplete, illegible, or cannot be completed, even if the problem is the result of the sole or partial negligence of Penn State. One entry may be made on behalf of each child who is under 10 years of age.

4. Selection of Winner. A winner will be selected at random each hour starting at 11:00 am and ending at 3:00 pm during the event. The winner of each week will be contacted via text that they are selected and must respond via text to claim the prize. Winning is contingent on participation only.
5. Prizes. The prize will consist of a PBS Prize Basket containing PBS promotional items. No transfer, assignment or substitution of a prize is permitted, except Penn State reserves the right to substitute a prize for an item of equal or greater value in the event an advertised prize is unavailable. Any difference between the actual value and the approximate retail value of any prize will not be awarded. No substitution or cash equivalent will be made.
6. Odds of Winning. The odds of winning a prize are dependent on the number of Participants and entries in the Drawing.
7. Taxes. Each prize winner shall be solely responsible for any federal, state, or local taxes associated with his/her receipt of the prize.
8. Claiming the Prize. Prizes must be claimed within one hour of the drawing. Prior to being awarded a prize, winners are required to provide their full name and confirm their mobile phone number. Penn State reserves the right to deny awarding the prize if the winner fails to provide satisfactory identification, as determined in Penn State's sole discretion. Penn State reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to award unclaimed prizes to alternate entrants or not to award the

unclaimed prizes. Any costs relating to the prizes, including travel, are the sole responsibility of the winner.

9. Release and Limitation of Liability. By participating in the Drawing, you hereby agree to release and hold harmless The Pennsylvania State University and its trustees, directors, officers, employees, agents, and representatives (“Released Parties”) from and against any and all claims or causes of action, including but not limited to claims or causes of action arising from third party claims of infringement, or Penn State’s own negligence and claims or causes of action for personal injury, death, or damage to or loss of property, arising out of participation in the Drawing or the receipt, use, or misuse of any prize. By participating in the Drawing, you also agree that you shall not be entitled in any circumstance to punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, or any other damages, including attorneys’ fees.
10. Publicity Release. Participant hereby grants an irrevocable, world-wide, royalty-free right and license to Penn State and the Released Parties to use, print, exploit, adapt, modify, reproduce, distribute, publicly perform and display any photographs, video, and/or audio (collectively “Media”) taken of me for use in promotional, educational, informational, advertising or commercial materials and communications in any from now known or later developed, including but not limited to publications, websites, articles, brochures, books, magazines, newsletters, exhibits, videos, films, social media, advertisements, and training programs (collectively “Materials”). Furthermore, Participant hereby authorize and consent to the use of my name, image, likeness, biographical information, and voice (collectively, “Likeness”) in the Media for all Materials or any other purposes deemed appropriate by Penn State.
11. Disqualification. All participants agree to be bound by these Rules. Non-compliance with any of these Rules will result in disqualification and all privileges as a Participant will be immediately terminated. Penn State, in its sole discretion, further reserves the right to disqualify any person for: (i) tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Drawing; (ii) gaining an unfair advantage in participating in the Drawing; (iii) obtaining winner status using false, fraudulent or deceptive means; or (iv) engaging in otherwise unsportsmanlike or disruptive behavior.
12. Reservation of Rights. Penn State reserves the right in its sole discretion to supplement or make changes to these Rules as well as the rules of any contest at any time without notice. Penn State reserves the right in its sole discretion to interpret the rules of any contest, and such interpretation shall be binding upon all Participants. If for any reason the Drawing is not capable of running as planned, including without limitation lack of significant participation, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or other causes which adversely affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Drawing, Penn State reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Drawing.
