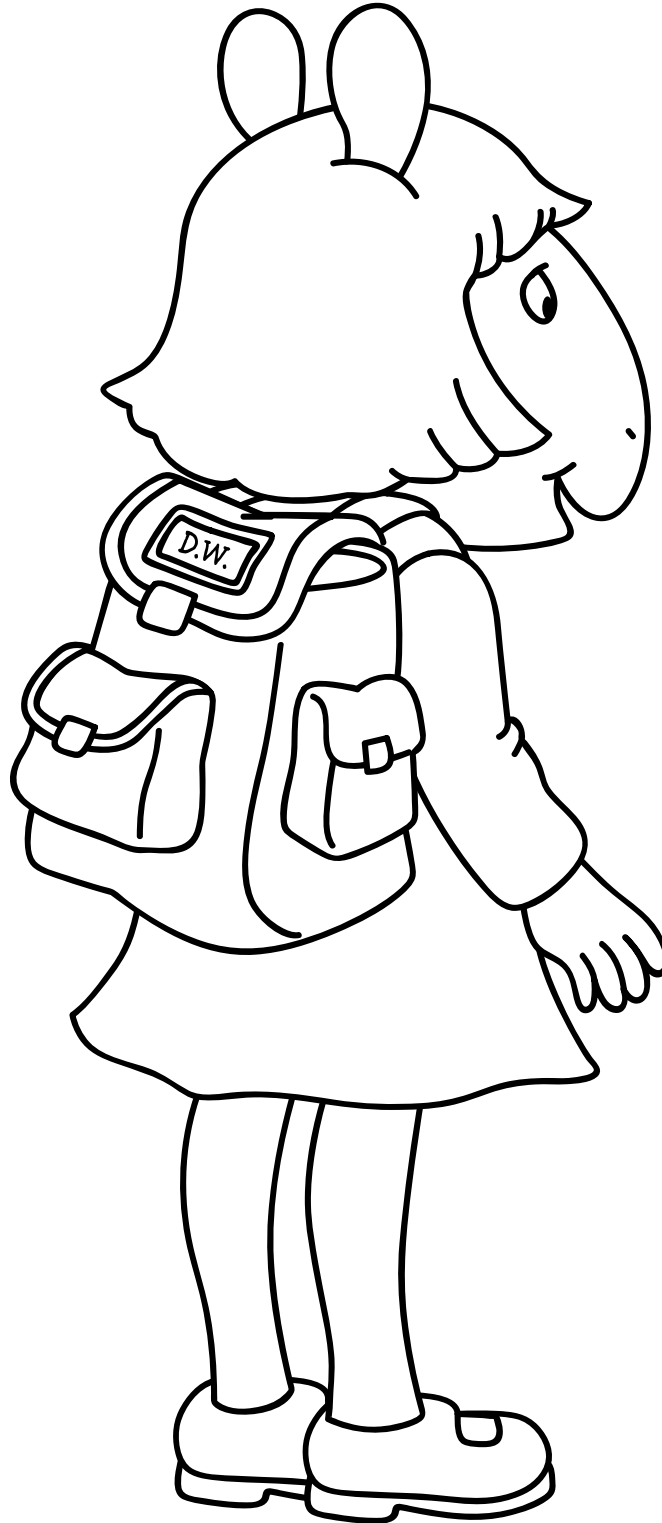

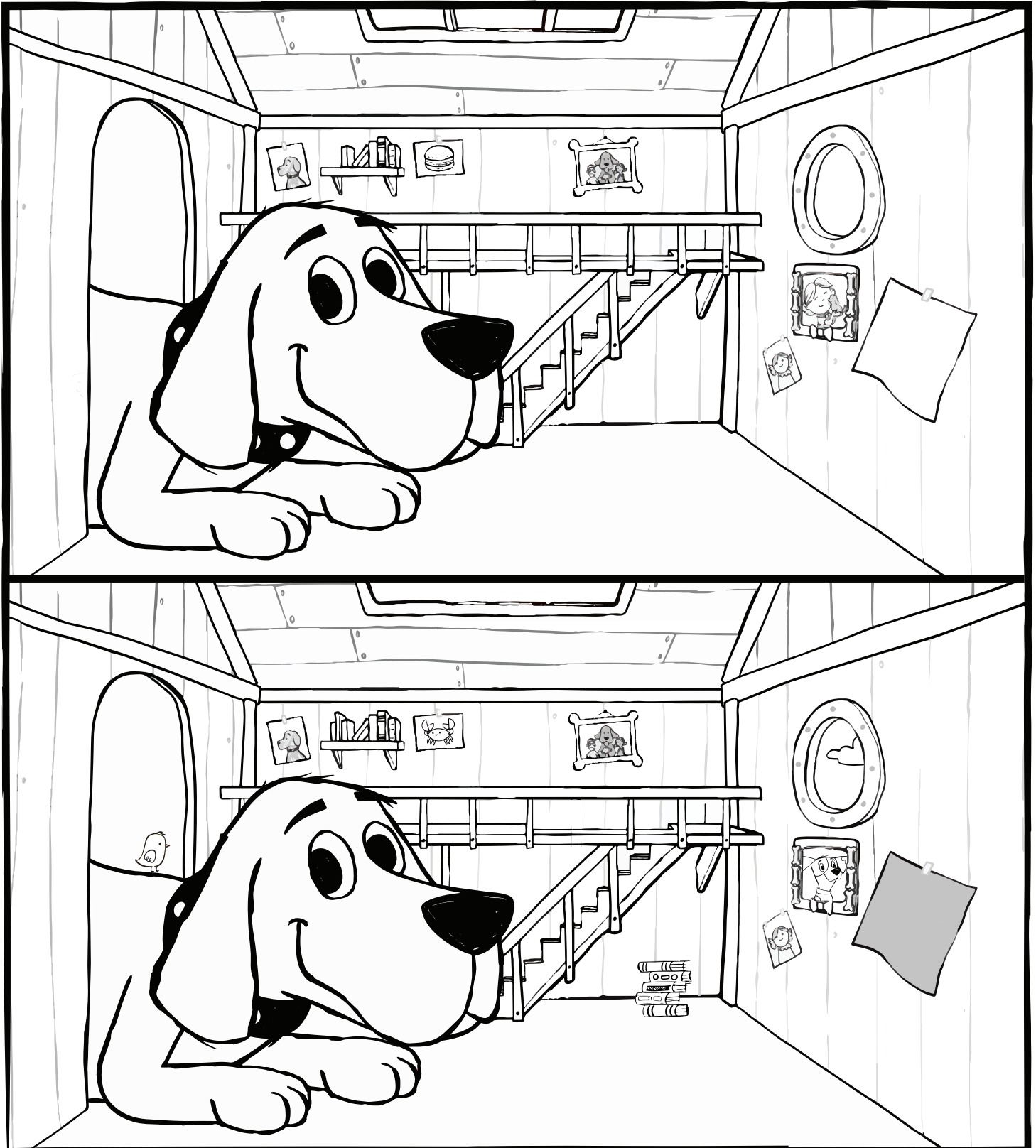
- **Big Toe Pose** put your feet together, bend over, try to touch your toes and hold it!

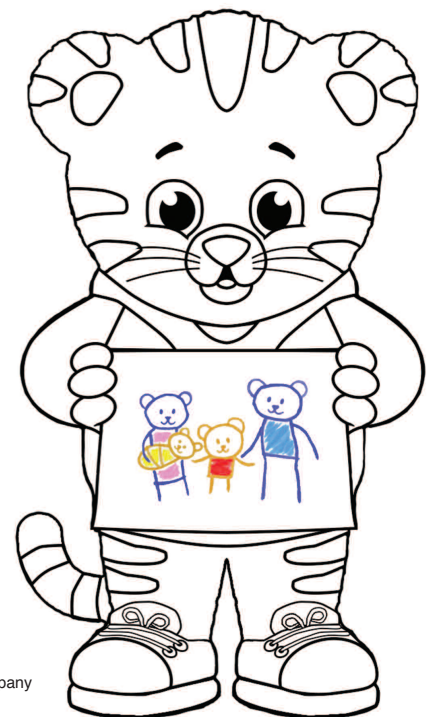

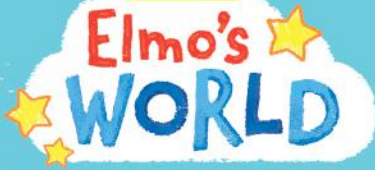


Elbow Tag!

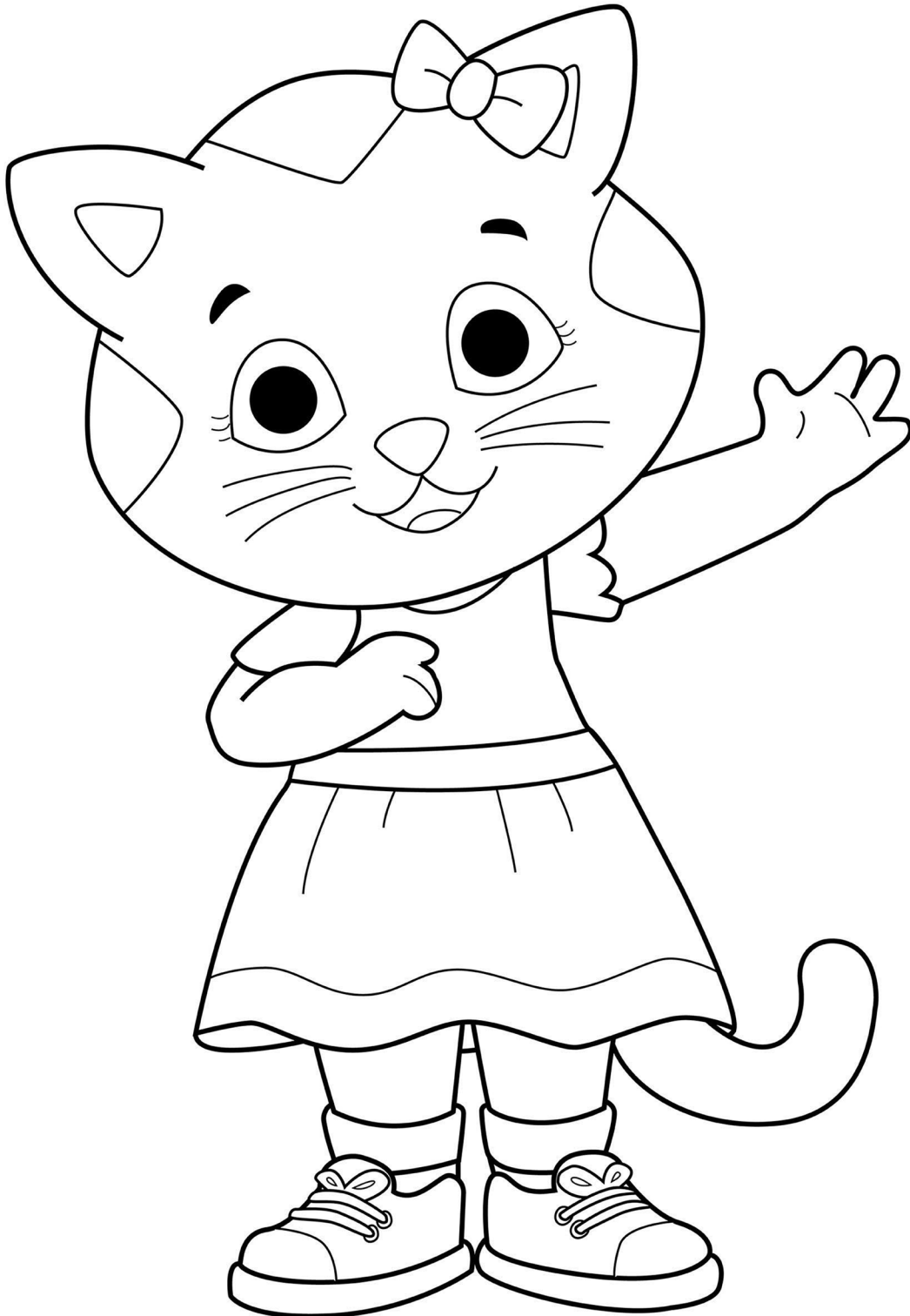

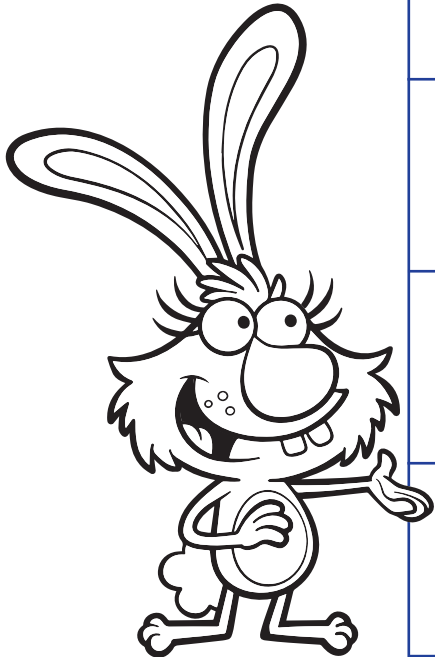

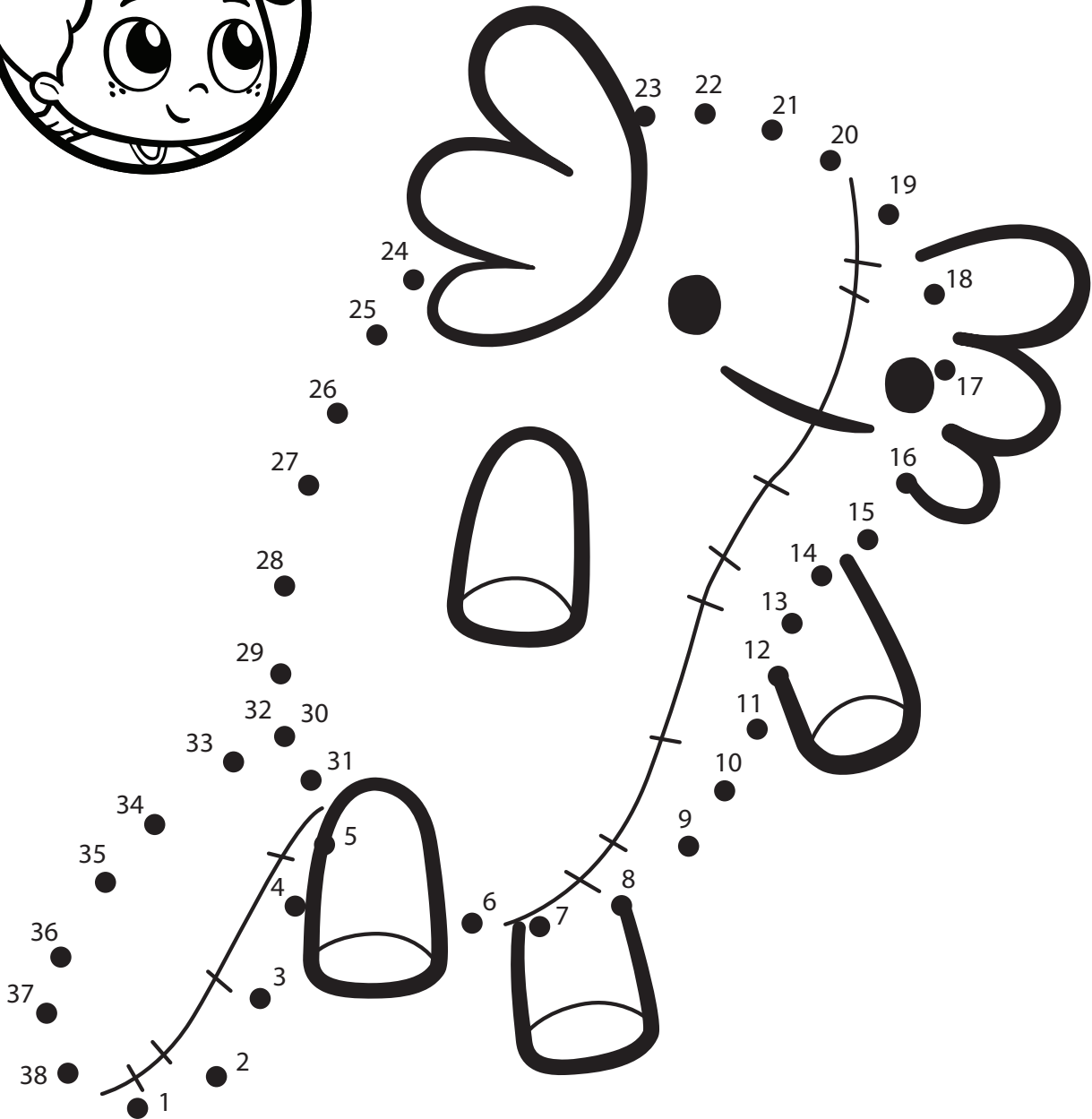
Rock, Paper, Scissors

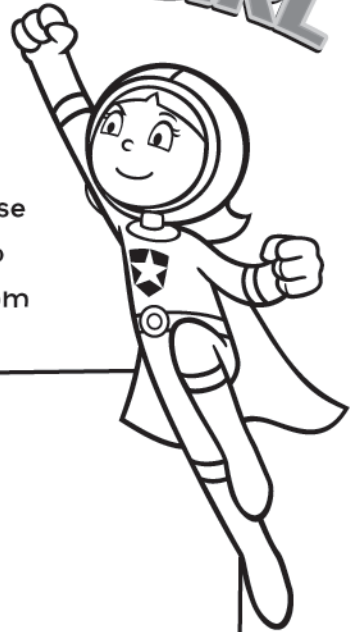

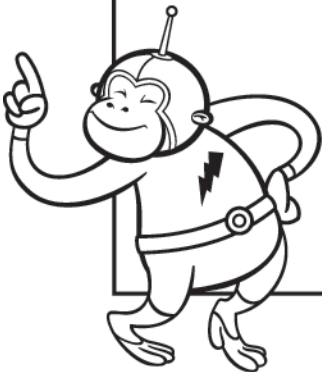
